Project Overview

A. Project Description

Washington State Community College (WSCC) is issuing this Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") to evaluate design firms for the renovation of the Arts and Sciences Building on the WSCC campus. The project will focus on upgrading the building's HVAC systems with modernized controls to ensure efficiency and code compliance, while also addressing the replacement or repair of all existing windows to improve performance, comfort, and overall building sustainability.

B. Scope of Services

The selected Architect/Engineer (A/E), as a portion of its required Scope of Services and prior to submitting its proposals, will discuss and clarify with the Owner and/or the Contracting Authority, the cost breakdown of the Architect/Engineer Agreement detailed cost components to address the Owner's project requirements. As required by the Agreement, and as properly authorized, provide the following categories of services: Program Verification, Schematic Design, Design Development, Construction Document Preparation, Bid and Award Support, Conformed Documents, Construction Administration, Post-Construction, and Additional Services of all types Refer to the OFC Manual for additional information about the type and extent of services required for each.
