

Dave Archer **Chairman of the Board,** **Pioneer Group**

Dave Archer is a lifelong resident of Marietta Ohio. His company, Pioneer Group, began in 1981 with the establishment of Pioneer Pipe. Today, it has grown to encompass more than 20 different businesses with more than 300 employees and is one of the largest full-service construction, maintenance, and fabrication companies in the Midwest.

As a community leader, Archer has made a tremendous impact on the Mid-Ohio Valley. Washington State Community College awards associate degrees in arts or sciences, applied associate degrees in business and science, associates of individualized studies, and certificates.

Members of Phi Theta Kappa, the honorary society for two-year colleges are noted on diplomas and transcripts. These students are recognized at Washington State Community College by wearing a gold stole over their academic gown and a gold tassel instead of the standard white.
