Candidates for graduation wear the tassel on the right front of the cap and shift it to the left front immediately after degrees are conferred.

Washington State College of Ohio awards bachelor of science in nursing, associate degrees in arts or sciences, applied associate degrees in business and science, associate of individualized studies, associate of technical studies, and certificates.

Honors Distinctions

Degrees with special recognitions are awarded to graduates who have achieved an outstanding cumulative grade point average (GPA) during their studies.

Summa Cum Laude (Highest Honors) 3.900 - 4.000 GPA

Magna Cum Laude (High Honors) 3.750 - 3.899 GPA

Cum Laude (Honors) 3.500 - 3.749 GPA

Honors distinctions are recorded on official transcripts.

Students receiving one of these honors are recognized by wearing a white cord over their academic gown.

Members of Phi Theta Kappa, the honorary society for two-year colleges are noted on diplomas. These students are recognized at Washington State College of Ohio by wearing a gold stole over their academic gown and a gold tassel instead of the standard green and white.
